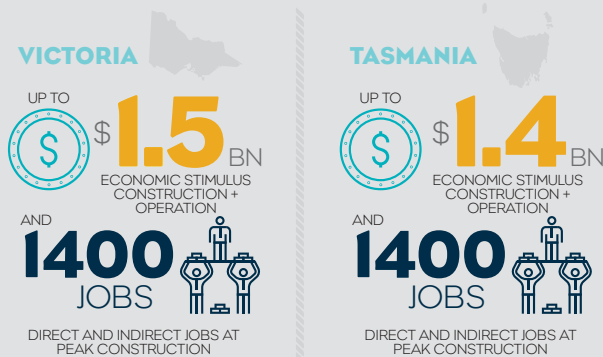


Direct and Indirect Jobs

Marinus Link will create around **2,800 direct and indirect jobs at peak construction and generate around \$2.9 billion** in economic activity in Tasmania and Victoria.
